



Luc Montagnier

August 18, 1932 - February 8, 2022

obel Prize winning virologist Dr. Luc Montagnier quietly passed away in the company of family and friends on February 8, 2022. Professor Montagnier was a maverick in the field of virology having won the Nobel Prize in 2008 for his discovery of the human immunodeficiency [AIDS] virus. He was one of those rare geniuses who never compromised on his principles and was more interested in the truth than in the dogmatism we so frequently encounter in those who subscribe to scientific materialism.

In 2010, Professor Montagnier published a paper, DNA Waves and Water, which took the medical and scientific community by storm. Montagnier filtered out all particles of bacterial DNA from a vial of water and discovered that the filtered solutions, containing no material particles, continued to emit ultra-low frequency waves! The implications for the potentized medicines used in homeopathy were obvious.

And so, in 2012, Professor Montagnier was invited to speak at the Joint American Homeopathic Conference in Reston, VA. I distinctly remember people walking out of the presentation saying, "I didn't understand a word of that, but now I know homeopathy is real."

In 2020, Dr. Montagnier was again invited to speak at the Joint American Homeopathic Conference offering a presentation entitled *Homeopathy – The Future of Science* and Medicine. The revolutionary talk was a real eye-opener for those unfamiliar with homeopathy's firm grounding in the scientific method and was greatly appreciated by all who attended the conference. Dr. Montagnier's passing is a great loss for all of humanity and he will be greatly missed.
